**Planting Instructions:**

Prepare the Soil:

- Clean the area by removing any debris, large rocks, or existing vegetation.
- Loosen the soil using a rake or a tiller to ensure good seed to soil Contact

Broadcasting Seeds:

- Use a broadcast spreader for even distribution, or manually spread the seeds by hand, ensuring even coverage. (Open Broadcaster just enough for largest seeds)

Seed Coverage:

- Lightly rake the soil after broadcasting to cover the seeds. The goal is to have the seeds covered by no more than 1/8" of soil.
- Alternatively, use a roller to press the seeds into the soil if available. This ensures better contact between the seeds and soil.

Watering:

- Water the planted area immediately after sowing to moisten the soil to a depth of 1-2"
- Avoid over-watering, which can cause seed rot.
- Water as necessary, especially during dry periods.

Initial Grazing:

- Let the seed mix grow to at least 6-8" tall before the first grazing session. This allows the plants to develop a strong root system and adequate leaf area to sustain regeneration after being grazed.
